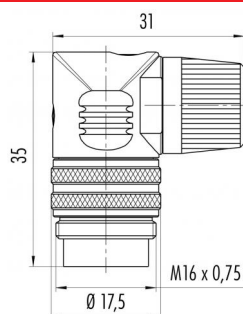

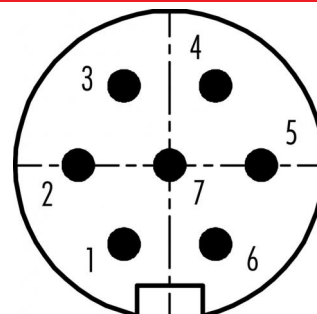

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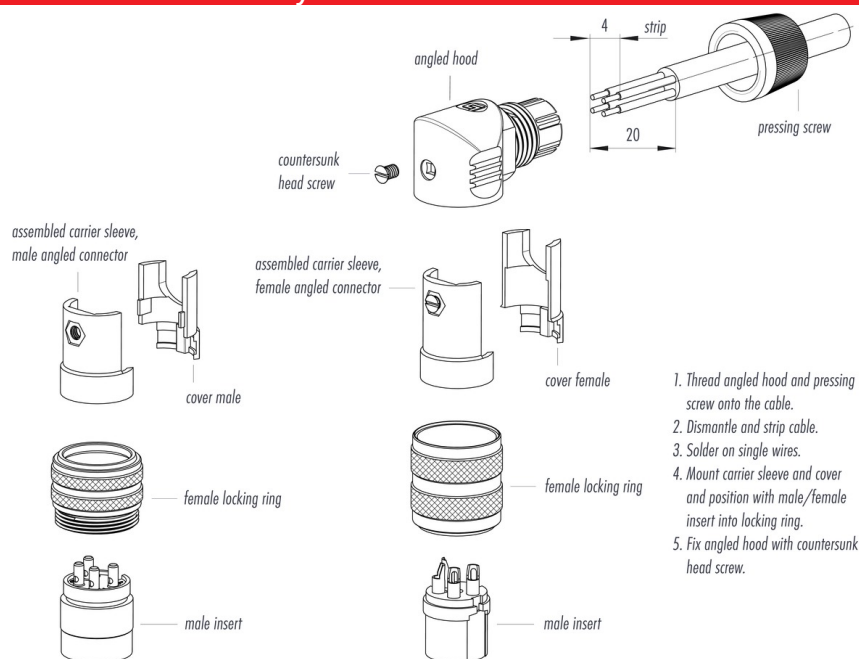

Connectors which are used in circuits with voltages dangerous to the touch may only be installed and used by, or under the supervision of, persons with electrical engineering training, taking into account the applicable regulations and standards.

To lock the cable connector with the device connector, the threaded ring is tightened "hand-tight" (approx. 50 cNm).
